Drugs worth Rs 16 lakh seized, seven arrested in Mumbai, Pune

MUMBAI: The Anti-Narcotics Cell of Mumbai Police has arrested seven persons including two Nigerians from Mumbai and Pune and seized drugs worth Rs 16.14 lakh, an official said on Wednesday. As much as 58 grams of methedrone and 15 grams of cocaine were seized during the operation, he said. The Ghatkopar unit of the ANC had received a tip-off about a five-member gang involved in drug trafficking, the official said. The gang members included two women, one of whom lived with her son at Kempas Corner in South Mumbai while the other lived in Marve Road area in suburban Malad, the official said. One of the women frequently traveled from Dadar to Pune by taxi to supply drugs to clients there, he said.

Maha govt launches child-friendly squads as pilot project for Mumbai

MUMBAI: The Maharashtra government on Wednesday launched six squads tasked with rescuing street children in Mumbai and helping them rehabilitate under a pilot project. State Women and Child Development Minister Mangal Prabhat Lodha said the squads will be equipped with a van, a caretaker, a counsellor and a teacher. "These six squads will be mobile and visit various areas in Mumbai. They will work for rescuing street children, counselling them and admitting them to NGOs or local schools. They will ensure that these children get a good meal and help in their rehabilitation," Lodha told reporters. He said the government wants to bring the vagabond and street children into the mainstream and ensure they get a good education.

Transgender community protests against BJP MLA Nitesh Rane

PUNE: Members of the transgender community on Wednesday staged a protest here against BJP MLA Nitesh Rane over a derogatory word he allegedly used while referring to Shiv Sena (UBT) chief Uddhav Thackeray. The protesters sought the registration of a First Information Report (FIR) against Rane. "Rane used gender, which is our social identity, as a slur in a social media post while criticizing Uddhav Thackeray. We have been demanding the registration of an offense against Rane for his post," said a member of the community. They were sitting outside the Bundgarden police station since Tuesday night seeking an FIR against Rane but on Wednesday the police, instead of acting on their demand, forced them to leave, they alleged. Smartana Patil, Deputy Commissioner of Police (Zone II), said the police initially asked the protesters to make way for a 'palkhi' (religious procession).

Angered by student's death, students vandalised Allahabad University

PRAYAGRAJ: Students of Allahabad University on Wednesday scuffled with teachers and vandalised some offices on the campus over the death of a student under 'suspicious circumstances', the varsity said. Some miscreants from outside led by student leader Ajay Yadav Samrat vandalised the university campus and indulged in indecent behaviour and scuffled with women in which some women teachers were injured, a university spokesperson claimed. According to the statement, the miscreants vandalised the Hindi and Sanskrit departments besides damaging some documents at the proctor's office.

Woman killed in explosion at illegal cracker manufacturing unit in Rajasthan

JAIPUR: A 25-year-old woman died in an explosion in her home in Rajasthan's Jhunjhunu district on Wednesday, with police saying crackers were being illegally manufactured there. The victim has been identified as Afreeen. She died early on Wednesday in the explosion at her home near Islamia Madrasa in the Udaipurwati area, the police said. The roof of the house was blown away by the impact of the explosion. The woman fell on the roof of another house where she died, they said. Her body was handed over to family members after post-mortem. The police have registered a case against her husband Javed and others under provisions of the Indian Penal Code and the Explosives Act. "Preliminary investigations revealed that firecrackers were being manufactured illegally in the house. Gunpowder was kept in the room where the explosion took place," the police said.

Evacuate immediately, Kejriwal urges people in low-lying areas as Yamuna swells to record level

PTI, NEW DELHI: The Yamuna in Delhi swelled to 208.05 metres on Wednesday, breaching its all-time record of 207.49 metres set 45 years ago, flooding many areas and prompting Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal to appeal to people living in low-lying to evacuate immediately.

According to the Central Water Commission's (CWC) flood-monitoring portal, the water level at the Old Railway Bridge crossed the 207-metre mark at 4 am on Wednesday, the first time since 2013. It rose to 208.05 metres at 10 pm and is likely to touch 208.30 by 8 am on Thursday.

The India Meteorological Department has predicted "heavy to very heavy" rainfall to continue in Uttarakhand in the next two days.

"I urge everyone living in low-lying areas to evacuate because the water level will rise suddenly and your life could be in danger," the chief minister said at a press conference.

As the water level rose to a record level, Kejriwal urged the Centre to intervene to ensure that levels of the Yamuna don't rise further.

In a letter to Union Home Minister Amit Shah, he requested that "if possible the water from Hathnikund barrage in Haryana be released in limited speed" and pointed out that Delhi is set to host the G-20 Summit meeting in a few weeks.

SIX MORE DIE IN RAIN-RELATED INCIDENTS IN PUNJAB, HARYANA; TOLL CLIMBS TO 21

PTI, CHANDIGARH: Six more deaths due to rain-related incidents were reported in Punjab and Haryana on Wednesday, while authorities in the two states focused on relief operations as the weather cleared after days of heavy rains.

The death toll now stands at 21, including 10 in Haryana, according to government data.

Overall, 14 districts have been affected in Punjab and seven in Haryana. About 14,000 people have been shifted to safer places from waterlogged localities in Punjab's Patiala, Rupnagar, Moga, Ludhiana, Mohali, SBS Nagar, Tarn Taran, Jalandhar and Fatehgarh Sahib districts over the last three days, authorities said.

An official spokesperson said 1,058 villages in 14 districts of Punjab have been affected by the floods. Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann said he is getting regular updates on the rain situation.

Hundreds of tourists remain stranded in Himachal, over 1,100 roads closed

PTI, SHIMLA/KULLU (HP): The Himachal Pradesh government on Wednesday claimed to have shifted to safety about 25,000 tourists from Kullu and Manali in the past three days but hundreds remain stranded as more than 1,100 roads are still closed due to landslides and floods.

The authorities after mobile connectivity was snapped are now getting in touch with the police and the district administration. Several messages looking for the whereabouts of missing persons have also been shared on social media.

Eight towns -- Manali, Solan, Rohru, Una, Ghamroor, Pachhad, Hamirpur and Keylong -- broke all previous records of single-day July rainfall, the Met office said. In four days, the Kinnaur and the Lahaul and

Spiti districts received rainfall equivalent to 43 per cent and 33 per cent of the entire monsoon season.

The state reported eight deaths on Wednesday, taking the toll due to the heavy rain in the past four days to 39. Officiating Director General of Police Satwant Atwal had said 31 people were killed till Tuesday.

According to the state emergency operation centre, five people were killed in flash floods in Kullu while two people died in landslides

in Sirmaur and Solan. One person was killed in an accidental drowning in Shimla.

12 men barge inside bus, shoot dead murder accused in Rajasthan

PTI, JAIPUR: Around a dozen men barged inside a Rajasthan Roadways bus on Wednesday and shot dead a murder accused who was being escorted by a police team for a court hearing in Bharatpur, officials said.

Another murder accused was injured in the firing and is admitted in a hospital in a critical state, they said.

According to police, the bus was stopped near Amoli toll plaza under Halena police station of Bharatpur by around 12 men who came in a car and two motorcycles. They entered the bus and hurled chili powder on the policemen and started firing on Kuldeep Jagheena and Vijaypal.

Jagheena and Vijaypal, accused in a 2022 murder case, were being taken to Bharatpur from Jaipur by a team of seven policemen led by a head constable armed with two semi-automatic rifles (SLR).

SP Bharatpur Mridul Kachchawa said the two murder accused were rushed to RBM government hospital in Bharatpur where Jagheena was declared brought dead by doctors, while Vijaypal is being treated in a critical condition.

Meanwhile, the police said they have identified the culprits with the help of CCTV footage and a vehicle has been recovered.

AP helping Centre procure tomatoes through NAFED

PTI, AMARAVATI: Amid skyrocketing tomato prices, the Andhra Pradesh government has appointed an official to help the Central government procure the perishable commodity from its market yard auctions through the National Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation of India Ltd (NAFED), said an official on Wednesday.

The state government has assigned the Joint Director, Kadapa from the Agriculture Marketing Department with NAFED.

"On Tuesday, NAFED officials called up and we have assigned our JD, Kadapa. They will also buy from Madanapalli and supply," Rahul Pande, Agriculture Marketing Commissioner, told PTI today.

As part of the Central government's strategy to distribute tomatoes to people from its end at reasonable prices, NAFED has tapped into major tomato growing states such as Andhra Pradesh and others to buy the commodity.

Pande noted that Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh are major tomato markets.
